



Toxic Substance Control Act - Import Certification Form

Chemical substances imported into the United States must be accompanied by a certification form indicating that the shipment is in compliance with the EPA's Toxic Substance Control Act. This shipment contains the following chemical substances:

Toxic Substance Control Resources

On December 27, 2016, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) published a Final Rule in the Federal Register announcing amendments to CBP regulations regarding the requirement to file a Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) certification when importing into the customs territory of the United States chemicals in bulk form or as part of mixtures and articles containing a chemical or mixture. That document amended the regulations to establish an electronic option for importers to file the required U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) TSCA certifications, to clarify and add certain definitions, and to eliminate the paper-based blanket certification process.
