



# Blanket Statement of Non-Applicability of Antidumping or Countervailing Cases to Imported Merchandise

CBP regulations require the importer of record (IOR) to know their products and determine if the goods are subject to antidumping and/or countervailing duties.

- Antidumping (ADD) laws assess duty on imported products that are essentially sold at less than fair market value into the U.S. and materially injure domestic industry.
- Countervailing (CVD) duties apply to imported products that benefit from a foreign government subsidy, thereby allowing foreign companies an advantage over domestic industry.
- U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is required to enforce and collect a cash deposit of the estimated duties established upon initiation of a case by the U.S. Department of Commerce and the International Trade Commission.
