

## **EPA Pesticides & Pesticide Devices: Disclaim Declaration**

## Do I need to <u>Report</u> or <u>Disclaim</u> Pesticides Information to EPA for my Product(s) or Device(s)?

**Pesticide Product** – Contains a substance or mixture of substances that is intended to destroy, repel, prevent, or mitigate (lessen the severity of) a pest. This includes substances that attract pests to lessen their impact, for example by attracting pests to a trap. Some examples include <u>insecticides</u> (e.g., kills or repels insects, ticks and mites), <u>herbicides</u> (e.g., kills weeds or unwanted plants), <u>fungicides</u> (e.g., kills mold, mildew, and other fungi).

How these are regulated: Must be <u>registered</u> unless it qualifies for an exemption.

**Pesticide Device** – An instrument or contrivance (other than a firearm) that is used to destroy, repel, trap, or mitigate (lessen the severity of) any pest such as insects, weeds, rodents, certain other animals, birds, mold/mildew, bacteria, and viruses. Works by physical means, such as electricity, light, or mechanics, and does not contain a substance or mixture of substances to perform its intended pesticidal purpose. For example, water treatment units that reduce or eliminate microorganisms from water are considered a device or could be a pesticide.

**Combination** – If an instrument, contrivance, or appliance incorporates a substance or mixture of substances to perform its intended pesticidal purpose, then it is considered a pesticide product. *How these are regulated: Must be <u>registered</u> unless it qualifies for an exemption.*
