Do I need to Report or Disclaim APHIS Core Information to USDA for my Product(s)?

A disclaim declaration is appropriate if APHIS Core does not regulate your product or if your product is regulated, but there are no data (i.e., LPCO) requirements.

Plants and Plant Products: Plant or plant byproducts with USDA admissibility requirements (such as an import plant permit, license, phytosanitary, seed analysis certificate, or other USDA related document) are regulated under APHIS Core and must be reported. Goods falling under this regulation include, but are not limited to, fruits and vegetables, propagative material, seeds, live plants, cut flowers, other miscellaneous processed items, as well as genetically modified organisms.

Live Animals*, Animal Products, Animal Byproducts, or Related Animal Products: Regulated products with LPCO requirements must be reported. *As of January 2021, only dogs require reporting.
