Additional Information

Under Executive Order 14068, as amended December 22, 2023, President Biden has further clarified that the prohibition to the importation of seafood and seafood products originating in the Russian Federation extends to products which have been further processed in third countries, regardless of the country of origin at time of entry. This self certification must be completed for all shipments of salmon, cod, pollock, and crab regardless of country of origin.

In order to enforce Executive Order 14068, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) will require a certification from importers of seafood and seafood products which states they did not originate in the Russian Federation. It will be the responsibility of the importer to perform the necessary investigation to ensure their product(s) do not originate from the Russian Federation and that they have documentation in their possession at the time of entry to support this claim.
